VISITING CASCAIS

PRAIA DO GUINCHO

Surrounded by dunes and Mediterranean vegetation, this 1km-long beach is located between Cascais and Sintra, in the Sintra-Cascais Natural Park. It's known for being windy and for its powerful waves, which have made it part of international surfing and windsurfing circuits and championships.







DUNAS DA CRESMINA

The Cresmina Dune extends over 66 hectares and is a part of the Guincho-Oitavos dune system. Raised wooden walkways were installed to prevent people walking in the dunes. They are of close to 2 km in length and enable visitors to see native plants that are only found in the area, together with the fauna and flora that form a delicate ecological balance with the dunes.







BOCA DO INFERNO

Boca do Inferno, "Hell's Mouth", is a chasm located in the seaside cliffs close to the village of Cascais. The seawater has access to the deep bottom of the chasm and vigorously strikes its rocky walls, making it a popular tourist attraction.







CABO DA ROCA

Cabo da Roca is the westernmost point of the European continent, located at the far end of the Sintra Mountains, and is undoubtedly one of the most emblematic places in Portugal. Visitors can purchase a certificate from the local tourism office.





CASA DA GUIA

Leaving Cascais, on the way to Guincho, on the cliff, Casa da Guia extends to the Guia Lighthouse and is contemplated by the immensity of the Atlantic Ocean. Both sunrise and sunset are unforgettable spectacles in this space. In these two hectares by the sea visitors can enjoy several restaurants, cafes and shops. You can also admire the magnificent view from the esplanades, terraces and gardens or from the open-air amphitheater.









FAROL DE STA. MARTA

Originally part of the Santa Marta Fort complex and now a museum, exhibits portray the building's history and techno-logical advancements over the years, as well as the daily life and routine of the former lighthouse keepers. Visitors can also enjoy the cafeteria refreshments on the terrace.









CENTRO CULTURAL DE CASCAIS

Set on the site of the former convent of Our Lady of Mercy and adjacent to the Gandarinha chapel, the stunning and colourful Cascais Cultural Centre hosts cultural events, conferences and contemporary exhibitions. The complex also offers a pleasant cafeteria with an indoor courtyard.







MUSEU CONDES CASTRO DE GUIMARÃES

Located in Marechal Carmona Park, this is the oldest museum in the county. Opened in 1931 it incorporates the Tower of Saint Sebastian, a remarkable work of romantic architecture that combines a mixture of styles and an engaging mysticism.





FORTALEZA DA CIDADELA E MARINA + FORTALEZA NOSSA SENHORA DA LUZ

Set on over the Atlantic, Cidadela Cascais is a unique example of fortified military architecture of the Renaissance in Cascais, defending the stretch of coast with access to Lisbon. It comprises the Fort of Our lady of Light and the Holy San Antonio Tower. Nearby to Cidadela, just a five-minute walk from the historical centre, you can find Cascais Marina. here are a variety of restaurants, bars and shops, plus marine services and the opportunity for recreational boating.









MUSEU DA VILA

A tile-covered building from the 1700s doubles as the Town Hall and a museum devoted to the history and culture of Cascais. It's located in the main square, facing the sea, and is worth a stop to get to know the town.





MERCADO DA VILA

This is the name given to the old Cascais market, which has welcomed buyers and sellers since 1952. Since then it has been transformed into a centre for restaurants, bars and terraces, themed markets and a place for selling produce. On Wednesday mornings it has a big old-fashioned market selling everything from bed sheets to Pinterest-pinned crockery, from shoes to jeans. It is connected to the fresh market, the Mercado Saloio, which sells fruit, vegetables, flowers, cheeses, and so on, and which also opens on Saturday mornings.

PRAIA GRANDE

A beach with a wide stretch of sand in the mouth of the Colares brook, easy to get to, with a picturesque tram that goes down the valley. There are lovely rocky formations surrounded by the small town of Colares. The space has a playground and typical restaurants that serve mostly fish and shellfish dishes.







AZENHAS DO MAR

The Mediterranean-looking village is a literal cliffhanger, with white houses tumbling down to the Atlantic, creating a picturesque scenery that inspired painters and graced postcards in the mid-20th century. A very small beach and a natural saltwater pool framed by a beautiful landscape.









SINTRA - HISTORIC CENTER

In 1992, UNESCO extended the categories of World Heritage and added the farmlands. Sintra obtained this classification with its typical and rich landscape, from the village up to the mountains. The old town of Sintra was an important center of the romantic architecture in Europe in the 19th century. With its Royal Palace, the Villa has a privileged position and a climate very own. Dozens of monuments make the delights of passers-by Sintra. The Serra de Sintra offers a huge variety of vegetation, paths and lakes and is also rich in cultural level, by the huge set of palaces and other monuments that gathers.









QUINTA DA REGALEIRA

An eclectic-revivalist architectural ensemble, with a particular focus on the Manueline, Renaissance, Medieval and Classical styles.







PALÁCIO DE SETEAIS

Seteais Palace is a Neo-Classical building, following the Renaissance values of Neo-Palladianism. The treasures in Palácio de Seteais include approximately 2,000 works from different fields such as furniture, lighting, textiles, tapestries, oils, murals, paintings, etchings and porcelain.









PALÁCIO E JARDINS DE MONSERRATE

The Park and Palace of Monserrate are integrated in the "European Route of Historic Gardens", within the "Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe" since 2020.









MU.SA - MUSEU DAS ARTES DE SINTRA

MU.SA, the Sintra Museum of the Arts, offers us a journey throughout the figurative art existing in the Municipal Collection of Contemporary Art of Sintra and the paintings and sculptures created by Portuguese and foreign artists residing in Portugal.









CASTELO DOS MOUROS

Isolated on its lofty perch, one of the peaks in the Sintra Hills, the Moorish Castle is a fortification founded in the 10th century during the period the Moors occupied the Iberian Peninsula. Its parapet walk provides stunningly unique views out over the town, the Palace of Pena and, further in the distance, the greens of these hills contrast with the blues of the Atlantic Ocean.







PARQUE E PALÁCIO NACIONAL DA PENA

The National Palace of Pena stands out as the renowned jewel in the crown of the Sintra Hills. The surrounding park, in close harmony with the magical character of the palace, triggers emotions of mystery and discovery. In its nooks and corners, our gaze gets lost amongst its charms.







CONVENTO DOS CAPUCHOS

Located in the midst of the Sintra Hills, the Convent of the Capuchos contrasts with the imposing and exuberant buildings prevailing elsewhere in Sintra. This Franciscan convent stands out for its sheer simplicity, completely lacking in unnecessary luxuries and comforts.







SERRA DE SINTRA

The Sintra Mountains lie at the heart of the Sintra-Cascais Natural Park. They are part of the only area in the world to be classified as a UNESCO World Heritage site both for their cultural interest and their natural beauty. The town of Sintra is of rare historical and architectural importance. The hills are a monument in their own right. Its natural beauty is magnificent, for the variety of its vegetation, trails and lakes and it is also quite rich culturally, for its enormous amount of monuments and farms.









LEISURE ACTIVITIES - CASCAIS / SINTRA

There's no shortage of reasons to go to Cascais and Sintra. There are those who go in order to know the heritage, those who prefer a good table near the sea, and even those that like to relax sunbathing on the beach. Others can't stand still and do every outdoor activity the region has to offer. The sports people fascinate over the golf courses surrounded by wild nature. 


